Kenya Odyssey – your base for explorations will be in National Parks as well as Conservancies that are adjacent to the Mara Reserve. We will concentrate in the best game viewing areas in Kenya that offer outstanding game viewing during the August/September season. This is the time when the big migrating herds of wildebeest and zebra gather in the Mara. With them follow the predators.

Conservancies are uncrowded, allow for walks, night drives and off-road game drives.

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN NATIONAL PARKS, PRIVATE RESERVES & CONSERVANCIES?

In recent year's there have been new and exciting locations opening up for game viewing. The excitement is due to the chance to really give to the local people who have lived on the locations for years and to have the chance for travelers to walk, take night drives and travel off-road. Many properties are leased from the indigenous people such as the Maasai and a part of the nightly fee goes directly to the village plus a fee paid to lease the land by the camp owners. It is important to understand the true difference between staying in one of the National Reserves (such as the Maasai Mara Reserve in Kenya) versus staying in one of the many privately owned and run conservancies which tend to be located just outside the main parks and reserves boundaries.

NATIONAL PARKS & RESERVES: *All are managed by the governments or councils who are responsible for maintaining the road systems, rules and security within the park. Each area has extensive road networks, open between set hours and unrestricted as to number of people and vehicles allowed in the area. With set hours night driving is neither allowed nor walking in the parks. It does not matter how much you pay for your accommodations, if they are in the park – there will be restrictions. That does not mean the experience will be bad, just more restricted and crowded.*

PRIVATE CONSERVANCIES/RESERVES: *The reserves offer a more intimate and active safari experience.*

Guests are limited in the area, although there can be several camps sharing a conservancy or private reserve.

Most conservancies and reserves will limit the number of vehicles that can go near a sighting. Although you may have to wait your turn – it will be worth the efforts rather than seeing 20 vehicles around a pride

29-30 August MASAI MARA GAME RESERVE

After breakfast in Nairobi you will board a scenic flight over the Great Rift Valley to the world-famous Masai Mara Game Reserve. Totalling 750 square miles and forms the northern tip of the Serengeti/Mara ecosystem. The Mara offers wonderful scenery and an amazing abundance of wildlife at all times of the year. Throughout the year the Maasai Mara is a place of natural drama, a kaleidoscope of color and life. The famed "Big Five" - elephant, rhino, lion, leopard and buffalo - roam the reserve, together with hundreds of other species, from the fastest animal on earth, the cheetah to crocodiles and magnificent birds of prey. Every year it hosts what is now recognized as "the greatest show on earth"; the migration. Over a million wildebeest and two hundred thousand zebras pass through the reserve on their endless journey, following the rains and in search of greener

31 August – 01-02 September MASAI MARA & NAIBOSHO CONSERVANCY

After breakfast, board your safari vehicle and head out across the plains (game viewing enroute) to Naboisho Conservancy, which adjoins the Mara.

Encounter Mara is a deluxe tented camp, simple in style, opened in 2011. It is tucked in a shady forest on the edge of the vast open plains of the Mara Naboisho Conservancy. There are no permanent structures at camp and purely canvas but nothing is left behind as far as comfort including hot showers and flush toilets. It is simple luxury. Travelers come back saying it was their favorite for intimacy and personalized services.

Game activities include game drives, followed by a picnic lunch or lunch at camp. Afternoon walk and then out again for another drive. On two of the days we will go out on all day drives, visit a Maasai village and have a picnic lunch. Night drives are each day and sundowners drinks are included before going back to camp for a late dinner.

Game walks are also included with an armed ranger. And, there is also time to visit a local Maasai village. These visits last about an hour, which a payment is prepaid to the community via the conservancy. This is a much richer experience than the average mainstream village visit with no heavy pressure to buy gifts.

03-04-05 September – LEWA CONSERVANCY

Dawn breakfast and game drive, then board a connecting flight to the Northern Central area of Kenya and the exclusive Lewa Conservancy. Located in the foothills of Mount Kenya, it has been described as a private paradise. We are not exaggerating when we say this area has some of the best game viewing in Africa. Spanning 62,000 acres, Lewa is home to over 10 percent of Kenya's black rhino population, over 14 percent of Kenya's white rhino population and the world's largest single population of Grevy's zebra. The area is magical and always a favorite of past travelers.

Activities: You may choose to go on game drives in customized four-wheel drive vehicles with open roof-hatches with professional guides. Or head out on foot with a professional tracker for an up close and personal interaction with the bush. Traces of some of the earliest humans have been found in this area.

Optional and subject to availability: Horseback safari and Camel Experience – Limited availability

Lewa Safari Camp – includes game drives, safari walks but does not include camel or horseback riding
